Job Description

California School for the Deaf – Riverside (CSDR), a member of California Interscholastic Federation – Southern Section (CIF-SS) seeks applicants for Asst coach in high school Boys wrestling.

Responsible for supporting the Head Coach in the supervision and development of the program. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting with planning and running game and practice sessions.
- Supporting the weekly monitoring of student-athletes' academic progress.
- Assisting with dorm and travel arrangements for the team.
- Helping promote the sport by providing prompt and accurate reporting of statistics and scores to the Athletic Department and local/social media.
- Carrying out assignments and tasks as directed by the Head Coach or Athletic Director.

Qualifications

- Knowledge and adherence to compliance with National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS), CIF-SS and school rules and dedication to the academic and athletic development of student-athletes are desired.
- Applicant must possess current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/First Aid and CIF/NFHS coaching certificates.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.

Who May Apply

The position is extra assignment for exempt teaching staff at CSDR. Civil service employees are eligible to apply for the position. Supervisor approval is required.
