Job Announcement Spring Season 2025 - High School Assistant Coach Coed Track & Field

Job Description

California School for the Deaf – Riverside (CSDR), a member of California Interscholastic Federation – Southern Section (CIF-SS) seeks applicants for an assistant coach in high school coed Track & Field.

Full responsibilities include assisting the head coach with the overall development of the program, and is not limited to, handling game assignments, facilitating structured practices that are appropriate for the age and maturity of the players, assist with weekly monitoring of student-athletes' academic progress, assist with dorm and travel arrangements, assist in promoting the sport, accurate reporting of statistics and scores to the Athletic Department and local/social media, and work on assignments as requested by the Athletic Director. Coaches are expected to be physically present, provide supervision and control of impulsive behavior, provide instruction, prevent foreseeable injuries, and respond to all injuries/trauma in an approved manner.

Qualifications

- Knowledge and adherence to compliance with National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS), CIF-SS and school rules and dedication to the academic and athletic development of student-athletes are desired.
- Applicant must possess current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/First Aid and CIF/NFHS coaching certificates.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.

Length of Work

- March 1- May 31, 2025

Coaching Differential

- \$2,750.00 for the season

Who May Apply

- The position is an extra assignment for exempt teaching staff at CSDR. Civil service employees are eligible to apply for the position. Supervisor approval is required.
- Non CSDR employees are welcome to apply and must submit applications 4-6 months prior to the start of the season

How to Apply

Interested applicants must submit a Letter of Interest, and current CPR & First Aid certifications to the Athletic Department.

When submitting a letter of interest, please include your coaching background/experience. Letter of interest will be screened based on the identified desirable qualifications and only the most qualified may be scheduled for an interview.
