# Job Announcement Fall Season 2025 - High School Football Head Coach

#### **Job Description**

California School for the Deaf – Riverside (CSDR), a member of California Interscholastic Federation – Southern Section (CIF-SS) seeks applicants for a head coach in high school football.

Full responsibilities include the overall development of the program, and is not limited to, handling game assignments, facilitating structured practices that are appropriate for the age and maturity of the players, weekly monitoring of student-athletes' academic progress, dorm and travel arrangements, promoting the sport, accurate reporting of statistics and scores to the Athletic Department and local/social media, and work on assignments as requested by the Athletic Director. Coaches are expected to be physically present, provide supervision and control of impulsive behavior, provide instruction, prevent foreseeable injuries, and respond to all injuries/trauma in an approved manner.

#### Qualifications

- Knowledge and adherence to compliance with National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS), CIF-SS and school rules and dedication to the academic and athletic development of studentathletes are desired.
- Applicant must possess current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/First Aid and CIF/NFHS coaching certificates.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.

#### Who May Apply

- The position is an extra assignment for exempt teaching staff at CSDR. Civil service employees are eligible to apply for the position. Supervisor approval is required.

  of the season
