Job Description

California School for the Deaf – Riverside, a member of California Interscholastic Federation – Southern Section seeks applicants for head coach in high school strength and conditioning.

Full responsibilities on the overall supervision and development of the program, which include, but are not limited to establishing and maintaining a strength and conditioning program for all sports, with the three major goals of improving athletic performance, reducing athletic injuries, and teaching lifelong fitness and movement skills. The S & C coach devises training plans according to sound scientific principles, supervise training sessions, evaluate athletes, maintains athletic records, and teach lifting and performance techniques to athletes and coaches. The S & C coach meets regularly with sport coaches to determine what the athletes need to work on. The S & C is responsible for maintaining the strength and conditioning facility, and for establishing the policies, plans, and procedures for the safe and professional operation of the facility.

Qualifications

- Knowledge and adherence to compliance with NFHS, CIF-SS and school rules and dedication to the academic and athletic development of student-athletes are desired.
- Applicant must possess current CPR/First Aid and CIF/NFHS coaching certificates.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.
