- Create monthly bulletin board in the hallway related to fitness goals
- Coordinate Fitness, Wellness Fair
- Become trainer of CPR/First Aid, Strength and Conditioning, and Water Safety Instruction; train the coaches, Student Life staff and Physical Education teachers
- Effectively utilize the services of CSDR staff (curriculum specialists, Student Life, speech/language therapists, teaching assistants, behavioral consultants, and volunteers) in the implementation of students' educational/fitness programs.
