General Duties

Career & Technical Education (CTE) Teacher in the Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) industry sector works under the direction and supervision of the Career & Technical Education Principal. CTE Teacher provides instruction and support to students in building a strong foundation of knowledge and skills in specific state approved courses of study and curriculum in the Information and Communication Technologies industry sector. CTE Teacher will provide and modify rigorous and relevant instruction to students in preparation for the CompTIA IT Fundamentals (ITF+) certificate, entry-level employment, advanced training, and/or career advancement in the Information and Communication Technologies related industry.

Basic Requirements

- Fluency in expressive and receptive American Sign Language (ASL) of at least a Level 4 ASLPI is required (evaluated through interview process)
- Fluent communication in standard written English
- Teacher: Possession of a Bachelor's Degree (BA/BS)
- Passage of the Basic Skills Requirement / CBEST or equivalent.
- Valid California credential(s) authorizing service for the position in which employed.
- Possess or be eligible to apply for a valid California Designated Subjects CTE Teaching Credential in the Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) industry sector.

NOTE – a Bachelor's Degree may be either a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science. Credentials must be approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Applicants who do not possess a preliminary CTE credential at time of hire, must enroll in a program to obtain their preliminary CTE credential.
